Dr. Craig D. Uchida is the President of Justice & Security Strategies, Inc. COURSE OVERVIEW:

This includes information about **Intelligence-Led Policing, Predictive Policing, and Smart Policing**. At the completion of the course, students will be expected to have:

- The ability to discuss and describe the differences between information and intelligence, predictive analysis, problem solving, and various models related to innovations in law enforcement.
