Officer Luis M. Gonzalez is employed by the City of Miami Police Department since November 1997. He is currently assigned to the Training & Personnel Development Section. He is a graduate of Miami-Dade Community College - North Campus School of Justice. He is a certified instructor in “high-liability” topics of law enforcement, such as Firearms, Defensive Tactics, Vehicle Operations, and First Aid by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement.

Officer Gonzalez is also a certified Taser Instructor, Sabre Law Enforcement Aerosol Projector Instructor, Glock Armorer, Remington Armorer, Specialty Impact Munitions Instructor, Simmunition Scenario and Safety instructor, Cooper Institute Certified Law Enforcement Fitness Specialist, ASHI Professional Rescuer, Bloodborne Pathogens, CPR/AED Instructor, and a FMTI certified Emergency Medical Technician (EMT-B).

Officer Gonzalez is also certified in Active Shooter Response, Law Enforcement Active Shooter Emergency Response (LASER), as well as Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training (ALERRT) from Louisiana State University and Texas State University respectively. Attended continual High-Liability training conferences at Tallahassee Community College on the campus of The Florida Public Safety Institute. These conferences offer various high-liability training courses encompassing various shooting techniques, defensive tactics, driving, first aid, and social science and physical science courses, as well as other related re-certification courses, in order to maintain proficiency and standards.

After 10 years of patrolling the City of Miami, he was selected to join the Officer Survival Detail. Officer Gonzalez is a Subject Matter Expert in First Aid training for criminal justice officers. He is responsible for the proper training of all in-service, as well as, police recruits enrolled in the Police Academy Class (PAC) programs in the areas of First Aid and CPR/AED certification. He is also charged with maintaining all current FDLE required standards in this field. Officer Gonzalez also assists in other areas of training, depending on the needs of the Department.
