Patrol Rifle Certification

For Law Enforcement Officers

The Miami Police Training Center is offering this (40) forty hour course for patrol officers and others designated to carry a long gun. The course is designed to enhance the officer's abilities to safely handle and patrol with the firearm. The student will review the basic fundamentals of the patrol rifle and demonstrate basic marksmanship proficiency. The student will also learn weapon retention, tactical movement and clearing malfunctions. In order to pass the course, the student will qualify on a 28 round course of fire from the 100 yard line down to the 3 yard line and pass a written test.
