Subject: HOME INVASION ROBBER LURES VICTIM VIA DATING APPLICATION



On March 16, 2015, at approximately 10:10 PM, Miami Police officers responded to 3200 Northwest 21 Avenue after a 911 caller stated her neighbor was being robbed inside his home.

According to detectives, the victim set up a first-time meeting with a man via a mobile smart phone dating application for that evening. The victim heard a knock at the door and allowed his invited guest inside his home. Once inside, the guest pulled out a gun, obligated the victim to lay face down on the bed all the while allowing his partner-in-crime to join in by opening the front door of the victim's home. Both robbers ransacked the house, filled two brown bags with the victim's property and fled the scene to an awaiting vehicle parked near the victim's home.

Both suspects saw a Miami Police officer arrive at the scene and fled, however a perimeter was established where both men were apprehended and taken into custody.

Roger Euceda, D.O.B. 5/29/96 and Gabriel Mieses, D.O.B. 4/21/97 were each charged with one count of home invasion robbery, one count of use of firearm during commission of felony and one count of resisting arrest without violence.

A third suspect is still at large.
