Subject: MAN FOUND DYING IN ALLEYWAY



On September 25, at approximately 8:40 P.M., Miami Police received a call about a man being chased and possibly hit by a car in the alleyway of 3416 Northwest 3rd Avenue.

According to detectives, once the officers and paramedics arrived, they found an unresponsive male with trauma to his body, lying in the alleyway. Fire Rescue immediately transported the victim to Jackson Memorial Hospital Trauma Center, where he was pronounced dead.

At this time, both Homicide and Traffic Homicide detectives are investigating the case, since it is yet unclear how the trauma that led to his death actually occurred.
