Subject: GAS STATION ROBBERY CAUGHT ON CAMERA

On December 2, 2015 at approximately 5:40 P.M., at 2745 Northwest 22nd Avenue (Shell Gas Station), victim#1 stated that she was working the cash register and dealing with customers. She looked up and observed the offender walking towards her with a gun in his hand, and stated, "Give me all the money." The victim did not react, and believed that due to her non-reaction, the offender thought that she didn't speak English and repeated the same demand in Spanish, "Dame el dinero de la caja." The victim then opened the cash register, and gave the offender all of the money inside, \$400.00 in U.S. currency as he pointed a silver and black hand gun at her head. Once the victim gave the offender the money, he then pointed the gun at victim #2, a customer in the business, and demanded in Spanish, "Dame lo que tienes en los bolsillos." Victim #2 replied, "No tengo nada." The offender then placed the money he received from victim #1 in his left pant pocket and he fled the gas station, running east on Northwest 28th Street.

Miami Police are looking for a **Black Hispanic male approximately 5'9" – 5'10"**, **weighing 150-160 lbs, medium brown complexion, black facial hair beard, freckles on his face, last seen wearing a black hat with white NY Yankees lettering, black hoodie, green khaki pants with white belt and brown Timberland shoes. He was carrying a two tone silver and black hand gun, possibly a .45 caliber.**
