Subject: BURGLARS CAUGHT ON CAMERA



Miami Police Burglary detectives are investigating a break-in that occurred to the Cubaocho Museum and Performing Arts Center located at 1465 S.W. 8 Street, on December 25, 2020 while the business was closed.

According to the owner, two unknown men burglarized the business as they made their way through the establishment's unlocked front door. Once inside, the suspects ransacked the restaurant and managed to steal the liquor, sculptures, cigars valued at approximately \$50,000.00. Both men fled the scene towards an unknown direction. The owner of the business reported the crime on December 27, 2020.

Detectives are looking for:

<u>Suspect #1</u>: White Hispanic male, 40 to 50 years old, 5 feet 9 inches to 5 feet 11 inches tall, approximately 225 - 240 pounds, last seen wearing an Echo t-shirt, green long sleeve jacket, dark colored pants, a green Adidas baseball cap and a diamond stud earring on his left earlobe.

Suspect #2: White Hispanic male, mid 20s, 5 feet 7 inches to 5 feet 9 inches tall, approximately 160 pounds, last seen wearing a gray hooded long sleeve sweater, jean tapered shorts, white sneakers and a low-fade haircut.
