THEFT OF EXPENSIVE WATCHES

Miami Police Burglary Detectives are investigating a theft that occurred on Saturday, April 23, 2022, at approximately 1:30 a.m.

On April 23, 2022, at approximately 1:30 a.m., officers responded to a home located at 3131 N.E. 7 Avenue. Officers met with the victim who reported that he left a nightclub with a woman and brought her to his home to have drinks and to hang out. The victim stated he eventually fell asleep and when he woke up at approximately 10:30 a.m., the woman along with his collection of watches valued at approximately \$200,000 were gone.

Video surveillance captures both parties arriving at the victim's place of residence at approximately 1:30 a.m., several hours later, the woman can be seen entering an elevator at 4:55 a.m., from the 36th floor alone while carrying a large orange colored bag. The woman can then be seen leaving through the lobby and entering what appears to be a possible rideshare white four-door vehicle, possibly a Camry.

Detectives are actively investigating this case and need assistance in identifying the suspect responsible.

Detectives are looking for:

Suspect: White female, medium-build. Brown eyes, long brown hair. Last seen wearing a brown tie-dye top with shorts. Black sandals with a brown medium sized handbag, along with a large orange colored bag with a white insignia in the center.
