VEHICLE BURGLARIZED

Miami Police are investigating a vehicle burglary which occurred on Sunday, September 6, 2020.

According to detectives, shortly after 3:30 p.m. officers responded to a call of a vehicle burglary at 2800 North Miami Avenue. Officers met with the victim/vehicle owner who reported that she parked her vehicle at the incident location and upon returning she found that miscellaneous personal items totaling approximately \$3,450 was missing from her trunk.

Video surveillance depicts two subjects who approach the victim's vehicle, try the car doors and immediately make their way to the victim's trunk where they retrieved two bags and a suitcase containing the victim's valuables. Both subjects then fled the scene on a blue scooter eastbound on N.W. 28th Street and then southbound onto North Miami Avenue.

Detectives are actively investigating and have since exhausted leads, and needs the communities assistance in identifying the subject(s) responsible.

Detectives are looking for:

Suspect 1 (driver): White subject. Last seen wearing a white t-shirt with long jeans, a black mask and dark shoes.

Suspect 2: (passenger): White male. Last seen wearing a yellow hat and shades, a long sleeve light colored sweater with long pants and light colored shoes.
