Subject: SPRINT STORE ROBBERY

The City of Miami Police Department's Robbery Detectives are investigating a Sprint Store robbery that occurred at 2200 Biscayne Blvd on Tuesday, June 11, 2019, at approximately 5:30 p.m.

According to investigators, the victim, who is an employee at the location, was working behind the counter when a subject walked into the store and requested to use the restroom. The subject then exited the restroom, approached the victim, and requested two iPhone SX Max's.

Once the victim retrieved the iPhones, the subject reached over the counter and grabbed both of them and began to head towards the exit with no attempt to make a purchase. The victim attempted to go after the subject, at which point he turned around and stated "Don't even try it, I have a gun and I have shooters outside, so don't even try to follow me."

No injuries were reported during the incident.

**Note:** The victim mentioned that the subject has entered that location numerous times, but never made any purchases.

**Suspect:** Black male, 5'10 to 6'0, slim built, unshaven, low fade on the side. Last seen wearing a blue long sleeve shirt with white dots (short lines), blue jeans with cuts, black sneakers and a baseball cap with a (Cheer Beaches) logo from CA State.

**Offending vehicle:** Possible Silver Cadillac CTS (with temp plate).
