## ARMED CARJACKING

The City of Miami Police Department's Robbery Detectives are investigating an armed robbery that occurred on Monday, August 31, 2020, at 99 S.E. 5 Street at approximately 11:00 p.m.

According to investigators, the victim, a 29-year-old male, parked his rental vehicle in the parking lot and made his way to the stairwell at the incident location when he was approached by three subjects who were armed with handguns. The subjects demanded the victim's car keys and went through his pockets at gunpoint. The victim in fear of his life, complied and handed the subjects the requested property. Several seconds after, all subjects entered the victim's rental vehicle and fled the scene westbound on S.E. 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Shortly after the victim noticed a red Chevrolet Camaro following the stolen vehicle at a high rate of speed.

The victim did not sustain any injuries.

**1<sup>st</sup> Suspect:** Black male, approximately 24-27 years of age, approximately 5'7" – 5'8", weighing approximately 130 – 140 lbs. Last seen wearing a black hoodie with black pants.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Suspect:** Black male, approximately 24-27 years of age, approximately 5'7" – 5'8", weighing approximately 130 – 140 lbs. Last seen wearing a gray hoodie with black pants.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Suspect:** Black male, approximately 24-27 years of age, approximately 5'7" – 5'8", weighing approximately 130 – 140 lbs. Last seen wearing a beige hoodie with black pants.

**Stolen vehicle:** 2020 White Ford Mustang Convertible rental. (recovered).
