Subject: ROBBED AT GUNPOINT

Miami Police Robbery detectives are investigating an armed robbery that took place on Friday, August 2, 2019 at approximately 9:15 p.m. in front of 5890 N.W. 2 Avenue.

According to detectives, two victims, male and female were awaiting their food from a local restaurant when they were approached by two armed male suspects. While one of the victims was walking towards the passenger's side of his vehicle, both suspects ran towards him with guns pointed and demanded his Rolex watch. The victim, in fear for his life, placed both of his hands in the air and lay face down on the ground while his pockets were searched. The second victim, who is a female, was sitting in the front passenger's side of the vehicle at the time of the robbery. She struggled with a second suspect as her purse and Rolex watch was snatched from her.

Both suspects subsequently ran towards an offending vehicle that awaited them.

Suspect 1: Black male, medium built, approximately 5'10. Last seen with his face covered with a black mask, wearing a grey hoodie and light-colored shorts.

Suspect 2: Black male, medium built, approximately 5'7. Last seen with his face covered with a black mask, wearing a black hoodie and dark colored jeans.

Offending vehicle: Black newer model 4-door sedan (Chevy Impala or Malibu) with a possible partial tag of "JEL".
