## FATAL DOUBLE SHOOTING

Today, December 13, 2023, City of Miami Police Officers responded in emergency mode to an apartment complex located at 801 N.W. 47 Avenue regarding a fatal double shooting that occurred shortly after 9:00 a.m. today.

Preliminary information revealed that an estranged ex-boyfriend arrived at the apartment building, entered the victims' residence, and opened fire, resulting in the untimely and tragic death of both a mother and daughter. Immediately after, the suspect fled the scene in an offending vehicle and have since been placed into police custody.

The Miami Police Victims Advocate Unit immediately responded to the scene to offer essential services and compassionate support to the family of the deceased as they navigate through this difficult time.

As the investigation into this heartbreaking incident continues, Homicide Detectives continue to actively investigate the circumstances surrounding this incident. The deceased mother has been identified as Irisbel Cartalla, D.O.B 12/16/1972 and the deceased daughter has been identified as Isbelsy Olivera, D.O.B 12/21/2000.
