The City of Miami Police Department Assaults Unit continue to seek for additional information in regards to a stabbing that occurred back on March 18, 2020. The incident occurred at approximately 8:12 a.m., in the area of 6201 North Miami Avenue (Little Haiti). On Wednesday, March 18, 2020 shortly after 8:12 AM, an older gentleman who was pumping gas at 6201 North Miami Avenue was approached from behind and stabbed in the lower back by an unknown subject.

According to detectives, while the victim was pumping gas he suddenly endured a sharp pierce to his lower back. The subject immediately fled northbound once the victim managed to turn around and search for help.

The victim was immediately transported via Miami Fire Rescue to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center. The victim has since been listed in stable condition.

At this time, investigators need assistance in identifying the black male subject caught on surveillance video while in the act. He was last seen wearing a gray hoodie with a red design on the front with gray sweatpants and red shoes.

Detectives need your assistance after exhausting leads regarding this investigation.
