Subject: MULTIPLE PEOPLE SHOT

Today, January 3, 2019, shortly before 3:00 p.m., Miami Police officers responded to the area of N.W. 20th Avenue and N.W. 24th Street in reference to multiple people shot.

Upon arrival, officers located two adult males who appeared to have been suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. Miami Fire Rescue responded to the scene and transported both victims to Jackson Memorial Trauma Center; while a third wounded male was driven to the hospital.

All three victims have been listed in critical, but stable condition.

Detectives are investigating leads and possible motives and ask that anyone with information to contact the Miami Police Department and/or CrimeStoppers.
