THREE MALES SHOT

Today, August 9, 2020, at approximately 2:42 p.m., Miami Police responded to a call of a male shot at N.W. 1st Place and 14th Street.

According to detectives, upon the arrival of police personnel, two male victims were located on scene suffering from apparent gunshot wounds.

Miami Fire Rescue responded to the scene and transported both wounded victims to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center.

Further investigation revealed that a third male self-transported himself to Jackson Memorial Hospital. All three victims have since been listed in stable condition.

Detectives are requesting the communities assistance for further leads on this investigation.
