ARREST MADE IN INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN INVESTIGATION

The Miami Police Department's Special Victim's Unit has arrested Gregory Wayne Freeman, 58, following an investigation conducted by the department's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force.

The investigation began after authorities identified the upload of suspected child sexual abuse material linked to Freeman. Detectives executed a search warrant on Freeman's cellphone, which resulted in the discovery of 30 files depicting child sexual abuse material, including both images and videos.

He has since been taken into custody and is facing 15 counts of Sexual Performance By A Child/Possession.

The Miami Police Department remains committed to protecting vulnerable members of the community and urges the public to report any suspicious online activity involving children.
