# LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AND COMMUNITY LEADERS JOIN THE MIAMI POLICE DO THE RIGHT THING PROGRAM TO RECOGNIZE STUDENTS AT THE SUMMER SALUTE AWARDS NIGHT PRESENTED BY BRAMAN MIAMI

MIAMI, FL – JUNE 15, 2022 – With school safety at the forefront, the Do The Right Thing Program (DTRT) is hosting a special evening to focus on students who have done the right thing including lifesaving acts of heroism, overcoming adversity, reporting criminal activity, serving their community, and other notable accomplishments. The DTRT Summer Salute Awards Night 2022 is presented by Braman Miami and is being held Wednesday, June 15<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 p.m.-9:00 p.m. at The Rusty Pelican, 3201 Rickenbacker Causeway.

The Top winners of the 2021-2022 school year will be honored with certificates awarded by Miami Mayor Francis Suarez and Miami Police Chief Manuel Morales. Four Students of the Year will also be announced including David Tamen, a senior at Miami Beach Senior High who will be honored for his project making 3D printed prosthetic hands and forearms for children in Haiti. Students of the Year are expected to be honored at 8:00 pm.

Do The Right Thing of Miami, Inc. is a non-profit organization, operating in cooperation with the City of Miami Police Department and other local law enforcement to recognize and reward children for positive behavior, accomplishments and good deeds. Since its inception in July 1990, the program has directly impacted over 250,000 students in Miami-Dade County alone. The Miami-based initiative has been so successful that 63 other law enforcement agencies in the United States, one in London, England and three in Germany have implemented their own Do The Right Thing programs.
