MIAMI ART WEEK 2024

Miami Art Week is a highly anticipated event that will take place in the City of Miami from Monday, December 2, 2024, through Sunday, December 8, 2024. The event is expected to attract over 100,000 patrons and will begin at 9:00 a.m. and end daily at 3:00 a.m.

To minimize the traffic impact on local residents and businesses within the Wynwood, Upper Eastside, and Downtown areas, the City of Miami Police Department strongly encourages the utilization of transit and/or rideshare services. Pedestrians are encouraged to utilize all crosswalks.

There will be traffic closures along N.W. 2 Avenue between 22 and 29 Street and N.W. 5 Avenue and 24 Street.

The following rideshare drop off and pick up areas should be utilized Thursday/Friday from 5:00 p.m. -2:00 a.m. and Saturday/Sunday from 12:00 p.m. -2:00 p.m.

- N. Miami Avenue and 22 Street
- NW 1 Avenue and between NW 28 and 29 Street
- NW 3 Avenue and NW 27 Street
- NW 5 Avenue and NW 23 Street

Miami Police Officers will be assigned throughout the area to assist with vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Residents who reside within the areas affected by road closures will be able to enter their complexes with police assistance.
