Subject: **RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY**

Detectives are investigating a residential burglary that was captured on surveillance video and they need assistance identifying the suspects.

On January 23, 2023, at approximately 10:30 a.m. the victim's brother left the home located at 5100 Block of N.W. 2 Terr. and locked the door. The victim returned home at 3:00 p.m. and saw that the front window screen was removed, and the front door was unlocked. The victim entered and noticed the house had been ransacked. The victim then reviewed surveillance video and saw that at approximately 11:28 a.m. two suspects knocked on the door, waited, then attempted to open the door. One of the suspects then removed the screen to the front window, opened the window and leaned in to unlock the door. The suspects then entered the home. A short time later the suspects are seen exiting the house with the victim's safe.

**Subject #1**

Hispanic Male, 35-40 YOA, 5'08" – 5'10", approximately 230-240 lbs., last seen wearing a red shirt, white shorts, black Adidas hat, black facial mask, black gloves. and wearing a Cuban link chain.

**Subject #2**

Hispanic Male, 30-35 YOA, 5'08" – 5'10", approximately 220lbs., black "just bring it" t-shirt with bull design in the back, slim blue jeans, dark hat, black shoes and black gloves.
