DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING PARADE AND FESTIVITIES

The Parade will take place on Monday, January 16, 2023. It will commence at 11:00 AM and end at approximately 5:00 PM within the City of Miami limits. It travels along NW 54th Street from NW 12th Avenue to NW 19th Avenue, then continues west on 54th Street into Miami-Dade County's jurisdiction.

Street closures are as follows:

- NW 54th Street will be closed from NW 7th Avenue to NW 19th Avenue. Motorist can use NW 53rd Street to travel on the north side of NW 54th Street and NW 55th Street to travel on the south side.
- The street closures will begin at 7:30 AM, however NW 12th Avenue and NW 17th Avenue will remain open northbound and southbound until 9:00 AM. The entire route will be closed to all vehicular traffic at 9:00 AM.
- The staging set up area is from NW 7th NW 12th Avenue on NW 54th Street. The staging area overflow will utilize NW 53rd Street (north side) and NW 55th Street (southside) to enter the parade route between NW 7th Avenue and NW 11th Avenue. The residents that live within the area will be allowed access.
- Miami-Dade transit buses that normally travel along NW 54th Street will be rerouted. Please check with Miami-Dade Transit Agency.
- Motorists are encouraged to take alternative routes if they need to travel in the vicinity. City of Miami Police Officers will be placed along the closure to provide any assistance.
- The streets are scheduled to begin re-opening in phases at 2:00 PM and the entire route should resume normal vehicular traffic at approximately 5:00 PM.
