FATAL STABBING

The Miami Police Department is investigating a tragic stabbing incident that occurred earlier today at the Icon Residences, located at 485 Brickell Ave., in the Brickell neighborhood.

Miami police responded to the 34th floor of the Icon Residences. Upon arrival, they discovered a male victim with apparent stab wounds. The victim was pronounced dead at the scene.

During the investigation, witnesses and security footage indicated that the suspect, believed to be responsible for the stabbing, fled the scene and entered an adjacent building currently under construction. The suspect was later found dead on one of the lower floors of that building. The circumstances surrounding the suspect's death are part of our ongoing investigation.

Currently, there is no threat to the public. We urge residents to remain vigilant and to ensure their homes are secure, especially during nighttime hours, to help prevent crimes and protect their safety.

Statement from Miami Police Chief Manny Morales

"I want to assure the community that we are thoroughly investigating this tragic incident. Our thoughts are with the victim's loved ones during this difficult time. We are also working to understand the circumstances surrounding the suspect's death. At this moment, there is no threat to public safety, and we encourage everyone to stay vigilant and take necessary precautions to secure their homes regularly to prevent crime and ensure their safety."
