HOMICIDE ARREST MADE

On June 20, 2025, at approximately 1:40 a.m., Miami Police officers and Fire Rescue personnel responded to a shooting in the 800 block of NW 70th Street. Upon arrival, they discovered a male victim suffering from a gunshot wound. The victim was transported to Jackson Memorial Ryder Trauma Center, where he was pronounced deceased shortly after arrival.

Witnesses in the area reported hearing an argument followed by gunfire moments before the victim was found. Their accounts helped investigators establish a timeline and focus on surveillance footage from the surrounding area.

Surveillance footage captured a black Nissan Sentra that may have been involved in the incident. The vehicle was occupied by two individuals—a female driver and a male passenger later identified as Eldrick Marquez Gavins.

On June 21, 2025, Miami Police conducted a traffic stop on the same black Nissan Sentra. Gavins was detained, and a firearm was recovered from beneath the passenger seat. Through electronic monitoring data, detectives were able to confirm Gavins' presence at the location of the shooting during the time of the incident.

Eldrick Marquez Gavins (DOB: 09/04/1984) has been arrested and charged in connection with this homicide.
