City of Miami Police to Mobilize for Operation Clear Track Rail Safety

On Tuesday, Sept. 16, 2025, during <u>See Tracks? Think Train® Week</u>, Sept. 15-21, **City of Miami Police** will join hundreds of local, state, federal and railroad law enforcement departments for Operation Clear Track to raise awareness and enforce railroad grade crossing and trespassing laws across the U.S.

During Operation Clear Track, Miami Police officers and FDOT will be monitoring railroad grade crossings for an opportunity to share the rail safety method with the community. The goal is to reduce pedestrian and driver injuries and fatalities around railroad tracks through increased public awareness. Federal statistics show that every 3 hours in the United States, a person or vehicle is hit by a train.
