OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING

On Monday, September 8, at approximately 6:45 AM, the Miami Police Department received an alert regarding multiple shots fired in the vicinity of NW 15 Avenue and 64 Street. Shortly thereafter, a 911 call reported a black male, dressed entirely in black, discharging a firearm in the area.

Responding officers arrived promptly and encountered the suspect, who was still armed with a handgun. During the confrontation, an officer discharged their firearm, striking the subject.

Miami Fire Rescue Services (FRS) responded swiftly, transporting the individual to Jackson Memorial Hospital (JMH) Trauma Center in critical condition.

As per standard protocol for officer-involved shootings, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) has assumed the lead agency role in the investigation.
