Subject: THREE SEPARATE SHOOTINGS; 2 DEAD, 1 CRITICAL



Miami Police Homicide detectives are investigating the circumstances surrounding three separate shootings that occurred yesterday, January 9, 2016.

At approximately, 7:57 P.M. at 1937 Northwest 2 Court, a man was shot multiple times. The victim was transported via Miami Fire Rescue to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center. He remains in critical, but stable condition.

Minutes later, at approximately 8:15 P.M. on Northwest 9 Avenue and 69 Street, gunshots rang out in an empty field, leaving a young man suffering from gunshot wounds while the gunmen, possibly two black males fled the scene. The victim was immediately transported via Miami Fire Rescue to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center, but died shortly after arriving. He's been identified as Alder Hill, D.O.B. 6/23/00.

At approximately, 10:15 P.M., while members of the Miami Police Department worked the crime scene at Northwest 9 Avenue and 69 Street, they heard neighboring gunshots, there too Miami Police responded and found that at the 700 block of Northwest 65 Street, a man was suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. He was transported via Miami Fire Rescue to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center. He died as a result of the gunshot wounds. He has been identified as Jaquan Leonard D.O.B: 9/18/94.

The circumstances surrounding the three separate incidents are unknown at this time. Detectives cannot confirm whether there is a link in between the cases.

The investigations continue....
